

TOCares Challenge Rules

- Challenge is open to residents of all ages in the City of Toronto. Submissions from residents outside the City of Toronto will not be eligible for awards.
- Submitted artwork must have an anti-gun, anti-violence theme.
- *TO Cares* opens to submissions on August 24th 2018
- Submission Deadline: Deadline extended to 11:59pm, Monday October 8th 2018. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Submitted artwork must be accompanied by a submission form.
- Mediums accepted: digital imagery, video under 4 minutes in length, recorded audio under 4 minutes in length, spoken word, poetry, poster, painting, sculpture, drawing, photography. Please ask if your multimedia piece is not listed.
- Entry forms may be downloaded online at <https://scaddingcourt.org/the-toronto-cares-challenge/> or picked up at Scadding Court Community Centre at 707 Dundas St W.
- Artwork along with entry form must: be e-mailed to TOcares@scaddingcourt.org; submitted physically at Scadding Court Community Centre; or received through mail at Scadding Court Community Centre by submission deadline. Should the submission be a video, a link to a website such as YouTube may be submitted along with entry form.
- Submissions will be grouped according to age for award eligibility: 5-9 years old; 10-14 years old; 15-19 years old; 20+ years old
- Only one piece of artwork may be submitted per person.
- Award recipients will be notified no later than October 10th. Those not receiving an award will not be notified.
- Selected artwork will be displayed in a public space.
- Awards will be presented at the *TO Cares* event and public showcase, to be held in October, 2018. Specific date and location to be announced soon.
- Artwork containing material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred, or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, sex, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, or age will not be considered.
- Artwork advocating any act of violence, simulated or real, may immediately be disqualified
- Artwork containing profane language or sexually explicit content may be immediately disqualified.
- Submitted artwork must be within the maximum size or length depending on medium used, or it may be disqualified
- Submitted artwork may not be re-submitted with revisions.
- Artwork must be original content, created solely for the *TO Cares* challenge. Do not submit any art with third-party content, copyrighted material, or content that was elsewhere previously sold, used, or displayed publicly.
- Scadding Court Community Centre reserves the right to use the submitted artwork for purposes related to the *TO Cares* challenge, including but not limited to promotional material, in social media, and for public display.
- Vote manipulation will be grounds to disqualify entries from award.
- Scadding Court Community Centre reserves the right to disqualify submissions from awards should the submitted work not adhere to the challenge guidelines.
